- I. Modality:Virtual (Online)
- 2. Modality: In-person
- 3. Modality: Synchronous (Realtime)
- 4. Modality: Asynchronous (Pre-recorded)
 - I. Self study
 - 2. Engagement via email, discussion, office hours, phone, video, etc.
- 5. Assessment: Formative (e.g. teaching efficiency)
- 6. Assessment: Summative (e.g. teaching effectiveness)
- 7. Hybrid
 - I. I & 4, 2 & 4 Great additional offline support, and absentee learner (e.g. sick, work, vacation, etc.)
 - 2. 2 & 3 Sick at home and remote learners
 - 3. Pedagogy for K-12 learners like 3 from experience
 - 4. Andragogy for mature learners like 4 from experience


EASY POINTS TO ENCOURAGE THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY TO HELP YOU

- Points for picture
 - screen capture
 - can better associate names with students.
- Points for proper name
 - Get alignment with official name in the registration
 - Attendance
 - Participation
 - Respectful and use of proper names.

SCREEN SHARING

- Instructor can use it to show diagrams, handouts, pages, etc.
- Instructor can also use it to illustrate writing and drawing
- Learners can also use screen sharing to show how to write
- Can use it for pop quizzes, etc. for formative assessments
- Note that zoom can record so learners can use it to demonstrate skills such as writings.
 - Use Zoom as an all-in-one tool.

IMMERSIVE ENVIRONMENTS + DEMO



CHAT + VIDEO + DEMO

- All chat can be recorded manually or automatically just for the instructor.
- Instructor can see all private and anonymous feedback for marking.
- Demo chat segregation by:
 - Separating chat section with lines
 - Add questions and notes to each section
 - Tell students to type but only press enter on your command
 - Close your chat section with "line" separator to cut off timer
 - Can use the "Do not show video" for similar surprise illustration.
 - Example, ask student to write an answer or find an object then everyone turn on their video at the same time to show their work.

BREAKOUT ROOM + DEMO

- Group work
- Can request instructor to come to the room.
- Instructor can broadcast into every rooms
- With Teaching Assistant (TA), divide and conquer the rooms to help students

- During teaching, struggling students can go to each breakroom with TA to get a more personalized help
- Room can be pre-assigned, random, or self-assigned
- Can use for office hours just like visiting a doctor

DISTRACTIONS + DEMO

- Mood enhancement
 - Bad weather Use virtual background
- Pets
 - Ask students to mute
 - Some students find comfort with pets with them
 - Stress relieve. That is why universities in Calgary sometimes do have pets on campus for students to pet, cuddle, hug, etc. during final exam period
- Kids
 - Engage kids so learners at still in tune and still in the learning state.
 - Normally, kids will get bored then leave.
 - When a learner break the learning moment, the learner may miss a teachable moment. That moment may have critical learning points.

STUDENT ACCOMMODATIONS (PLEASE PARDON MY POLITICAL CORRECTNESS) (PART 1/2)

- Instructor's challenges
 - Accent, tone, volume
- Foreign learners
 - Attend synchronously on-line for most time zones or setup an additional time to cover the remainder time zones.
 - Pre-recorded for off-line asynchronous learning
 - Close captioned for translation
 - Can use chat for feedback because most foreign learners can type better than they can speak.
 - Can provide feedback directly to the instructor
 - Can use Teaching Assistant (TA) to help with monitoring and response

STUDENT ACCOMMODATIONS (PLEASE PARDON MY POLITICAL CORRECTNESS) (PART 2/2)

- Slower learners
 - Ability to record teaching
 - Remind Learners about privacy and recording retention (normally 2 weeks only)
- Deaf
 - Sharing screen with sign interpreter
 - Real-time close captioning
- Mute
 - Can type and read correspondence
- Vision Impaired
 - Can zoom and perform read out loud

- Try one feature a few times before you learn and add more features to your teaching


